**ORDER GRANTING AGREED MOTION TO STAY EXECUTION OF THE -912
JUDGMENT AND TO SET A BRIEFING SCHEDULE FOR THE PARTIES' POST-
TRIAL MOTIONS**

The Court, having considered the parties' Agreed Motion (Dkt. No. 602), hereby GRANTS said motion. It is hereby ORDERED that:


- The Court stays execution of the Final Judgment in the -912 case (Case No. 2:14-cv-912, ECF No. 47) pending disposition of all of the post-trial motions in the -912 case filed by either party. Defendants shall not be required to post a bond at this time and shall have 14 days from entry of the last of the orders on the post-trial motions in the -912 case to make suitable arrangements for a bond or substitute security, if necessary.
- The deadline for Plaintiff to seek costs under §1920 shall be extended until 14 days after the resolution of Defendants' post-trial motions.
- The deadline for Plaintiff's remaining post-trial motions—seeking attorneys' fees and costs under Section 285 and Rule 54, supplemental damages for post-verdict infringement, ongoing royalties for adjudged infringing products and those not colorably different, pre- and post-judgment interest, and a correction and/or

amendment to the Final Judgment to reflect the same—shall be extended until at least November 30, 2016, with the final deadline to be set forth in a separate Order after the Court considers the parties’ competing views on the matter.

- The briefing schedule and page limits for Defendants’ post-trial motions in the -912 case shall be as follows:

Current Deadline	Revised Deadline	Event in the -912 case
Wednesday November 30, 2016	Wednesday November 30, 2016	Defendants to file post-trial motions under Rule 50, 59, and/or 60 (up to 60 pages total)
Monday December 19, 2016	Wednesday January 4, 2017	Plaintiff to file oppositions to Defendants’ post-trial motions (up to 60 pages total)
Thursday December 29, 2016	Wednesday January 25, 2017	Defendants to file replies in support of their post-trial motions (up to 20 pages total)
Monday January 9, 2017	Wednesday February 8, 2017	Plaintiff to file sur-replies to Defendants’ post-trial motions (up to 20 pages total)
